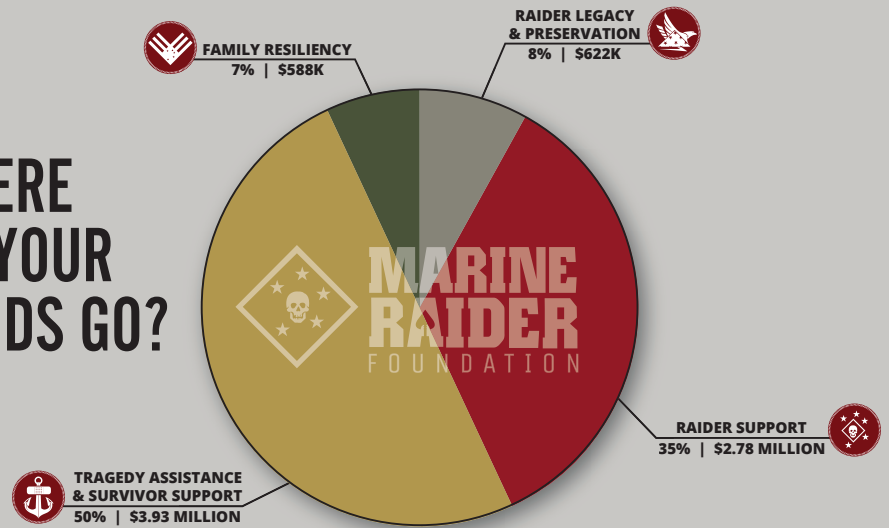
Since 2012, the Marine Raider Foundation has provided over **\$7.9 million** in support to Raiders & their families.

MARSOC HISTORY & MISSION

U.S. Marine Corps Forces Special Operations Command (MARSOC) is the Marine Corps service component to the U.S. Special Operations Command (USSOCOM). Dating back to the Marine Raiders of WWII, MARSOC trains, equips & deploys task-organized, scalable & responsive Raider teams in support of Combatant Commanders & other agencies.

Raiders conduct foreign internal defense, special reconnaissance & direct-action missions across the globe as assigned by USSOCOM on a priority basis. Raiders train, advise, & assist partner nations by conducting missions of Foreign Internal Defense. They continuously deploy throughout the world due to Special Operations Forces being the nation's "Force of Choice," thus increasing the demands on Raiders & their families.

PRIMARY SERVICES

TRAGEDY ASSISTANCE & SURVIVOR SUPPORT

For Marine Raiders managing wounds, injuries, and conditions resulting from their service, we provide ongoing support throughout the phases of their care. The goal of this program is to ensure that the heroes receive all the treatments and tools necessary.

This includes:

- Funding advanced rehabilitation programs, innovative equipment, medical equipment and innovative treatments not covered by military health insurance
- Alternative treatments and therapies not covered by the DoD or VA, including mental health and addiction treatment
- Hosting the annual Resiliency/Remembrance Event for Gold Star families to keep them connected with one another and their extended Marine Raider family
- Funding travel for family members to be bedside following surgeries or hospitalization
 - Hosting and funding commemorative events and memorials honoring MARSOC's fallen heroes
 - Funding travel for Gold Star Families and active-duty Raiders to attend the funeral services and commemorations for fallen Marine Raiders
 - Adaptive equipment, orthotics, and braces needed for mobility or quality of life
 - Emergency childcare



RAIDER SUPPORT

As active duty and retired Raiders transition out of the military and approach their next mission in life, the Marine Raider Foundation provides them with the tools and assistance needed to ensure they succeed.

- One-time Transition Assistance Grants for Raiders re-entering the civilian sector following service to our Country
- Access to mentors & support of career transition programs & events
- Funding for programs, awards & ceremonies that recognize & promote Raiders' personal and professional resiliency

Funding for childcare & emergency services for Raider families facing health & welfare challenges. Advocacy & funding of services for Raider family member with special needs. Funding for events that enhance resiliency for Raider families

The most important line of support for our Raiders is their family, so it is critical that we are there to support! The Marine Raider Foundation helps Raider families with out-of-pocket expenses related to family medical emergencies, including those of special needs family members. Our programming includes support for events that enhance morale and resiliency and reintegration post-deployment. The Family Resiliency Program is structured on the belief of empowering the spouses and children of Marine Raiders to help them navigate life in the Special Operations realm. Raider families are the backbone of this community.
